FORMER SPEAKER OF THE FLORIDA HOUSE WILL WEATHERFORD ENDORSES ED HOOPER

Clearwater – Former Florida House Speaker Will Weatherford has endorsed Ed Hooper for the State Senate.

He was previously elected to the Clearwater City Council and spent eight years in the Florida House before retiring in 2014 due to term limits. Hooper, who currently spends his time as a consultant, has a long history of involvement in the Clearwater Chamber of Commerce, Leadership Pinellas, and the Pinellas County Republican Executive Committee. He and his wife Lee live in Clearwater. They have four children and ten grandchildren. Florida Senate District 16 includes northern Pinellas County and southwestern Pasco County. Other recent endorsements include State Senators Jack Latvala, Jeff Brandes and Dana D. Young, Pinellas County Sheriff Bob Gualtieri, and Pasco County Sheriff Chris Nocco.
